Some 4 million grandchildren live with their grandparents. **Jim and Sherry Banks** matched the \$100 entrusted to them and gave it to "Ounce of Prevention" which serves grandparents raising grandchildren. Sherry's sister in Tennessee is in that situation; Jim and Sherry are happy to see the money help grandparents in similar circumstances. The Banks attend our 11:15 service.

Bradley Combs worked with his

grandmother **Joan Johnson** on his Kingdom Assignment. Together they thought long and hard about how to use the money before deciding to split it four ways. They had an extra \$100 to work with since Joan and husband Don kicked in \$50 and Joan's sister did the same. \$100 went to BEAM (Beaches Emergency Assistance Ministry), \$50 to the Ponte Vedra Boy Scouts, \$25 to the Florida United Methodist Children's Home (Enterprise, FL) and \$25 right back to PVUMC. Bradley worships weekly at 11:15 with his parents **Martin and DeAnn Combs**, sister **Danielle** and grandparents **Don and Joan Johnson**.
