A Word from Wesley

John Wesley, the father of Methodism, considered himself to be *homo unius libri*, a man of one book. A word from Wesley about that book, the Bible:

There are four grand and powerful arguments which strongly induce us to believe that the Bible must be from God, viz., miracles, prophecies, the godness of the doctrine, and the moral character of the penman. All the miracles flow from divine power; all the prophecies, from divine understanding; the godness of the doctrine, from divine goodness; and the moral character of the penmen, from divine holiness.

PVUMC Hosts Community Bible Study

A women's Community Bible Study (CBS) is forming in Ponte Vedra Beach and we are privileged to be the host church. The class is meeting on Tuesdays at 9:30am for 1½ to 2 hours. They will meet once a week for 30 weeks, coinciding with the public school calendar. Before coming to class, each person is asked to read the week's scripture and answer related questions. Upon coming to class, the member goes to their Core Group of about 15 to share their home study questions and answers. The core group is led by a trained leader and consists of people from various backgrounds and church denominations. At the end of the Core Group time, groups move to a central area to hear a 20 - 30 minute lecture on the same passage prepared by a Teaching Director. The class member leaves with a commentary on that week's lesson and questions for the next week's study.

And my thoughts than your thoughts

Isaiah 55:8-9

There's comfort in knowing that just because we can't make sense of what's going on, doesn't mean it's senseless. God's thoughts and ways are higher than ours. So we continue in faith, doing what we know to do, which for the Trustees means checking out every angle we can think of. Like the apostle Paul, we are "perplexed, but not driven to despair."
