

Katie and I are willing to car swap our Saturn or Honda Element if necessary. This retreat also contains the confirmation components for Ponte Vedra United Methodist. Even if you're already a Confirmation graduate, there's still plenty for you to get out of this retreat. Join us for food, fun, music, and discussion at Epworth by the Sea. Youth Mission Trip to Atlanta Finalized

We've secured the week of Sunday June 4th through Saturday June 10th with the DOOR project in Atlanta! I mentioned earlier we were trying for two consecutive weeks to keep dates flexible, but we were asked by DOOR to commit to one week only. No matter, we've got our dates and we're ready to count down the days to our missions and service opportunity. Early discussion shows all of last year's alumni will be returning and several students are excited to be joining us for the first time. The DOOR project serves Atlanta by matching student and adult volunteers to service projects focusing on persons directly affected by extreme poverty and homelessness. A question that arises whenever we talk about this trip is, "But is it safe?" The answer is a resounding Yes! We stay together and travel as a group. The church we sleep in at night is locked 24 hours, with participants having to be buzzed in by a staff member (one of which is on premises at all times). The cost is \$350 and I'm asking for a \$100 nonrefundable deposit to be made by Sunday May 7th. The remaining \$250 may be paid on your own schedule with the balance due by the time we depart on Sunday, June 4th. If you are in need of financial assistance, please ask; we would love to help you. Conversely, if you are interested in helping families by financing some or all of students' costs, please let me or Pastor Jeff know. I would also like to match persons willing to donate for services with students willing to work for assistance. If you have any reasonable tasks you would like to have done in exchange for donations to the youth mission trip, please let me know. It would also be an enormous benefit to us if you would lend us a vehicle that can carry 6 or more passengers; we will need two of these. Thank you for all you do in support of our students as they grow in relationship with others and with God. We look forward to another excellent and meaningful trip to Atlanta!
