Did you know that PVUMC has a sister church in Cuba? Did you know about the Cuba-Florida Covenant, a covenant between the Methodist churches in Cuba and Florida that support each other in Christian work?

PVUMC's sister church is LaSierra; Damian Pacheo Diaz began serving as pastor at La Sierra about a year ago. The church has 52 members with attendance of around 60 adults and 20 children. Nine Jacksonville area United Methodists are heading to Cuba to visit La Sierra on December 4 for one week including our members Ellen Carson, Loree Reed and George Reed.

Money Matters


An occasional column on things financial
