Notice the white ribbons on our property? All trees greater than 8" diameter along with buildings and other property features have now been mapped to a digital survey in anticipation of site design. Our Building Design Team (John McEvoy - chair, Cooper Agent, Suzanne Joyner, James Pyle, Dotty Rashba) will soon be reviewing conceptuals by Ron Scalisi Architects. Cargill Associates has been retained to prepare us for and walk with us through the spring capital campaign. They will recommend a campaign goal to Finance by the second week of December. We are moving forward!



We will NOT have youth group on Sunday, December 30. Spend some time with your families!!!!




Kids Christmas Party

He can be seen walking alone down Ponte Vedra Lakes Boulevard. You will notice that he's wearing a floppy hat and carries a white cane. If you approach him, you will find that he also carries a smile and a love for interaction. **Orrin Hall** will be the first to tell you to avoid riding with him if he's driving. "Take the bus instead," he would tell you, as macular degeneration has put his vision in an almost total fog. Nevertheless, despite this, our ecumenical friend volunteers through several affiliations.

Orrin has a Masters in Divinity and in English studies and is an ordained United Methodist Minister. He served 20 years as a minister in Hartford, CT, in Talladega, AL, and in the New York City area. For 20 years, he was an English professor in North Dakota, Alabama, and in the Jacksonville area, of which nine years were at Jacksonville University. Through Naval contracts with college professors, he deployed for several years, 10 weeks at a time, traveling around the world. Orrin has been married to his lovely wife, Martha, for 57 years. They have 7 children and 12 grandchildren.

Currently, Orrin volunteers for Baptist Home Healthcare, making phone calls and some house calls to outpatients. He does the same for the homebound and sick through Hart Felt Ministries. Orrin led one of our small Bible study groups, Traveling Tuesdays, for several years.
