Campaign Followup

At 32 months into our 36-month *Building on Faith* capital campaign, we have received nearly **82%** of funds pledged. Well done, church!

To those who have pledged to the *Building on Faith* capital campaign, please continue to give against those pledges. (And thank you very much for what you’ve given to date.) To those who have so freely given to the building fund outside the campaign, we thank you too!

At present we’re required to pay interest; principal payments are optional. Beginning in January the balance of the loan will be amortized over 19 years and we will be paying both principal and interest. **Every gift given between now and January 9 reduces the principal we owe** as well as the interest we pay today *and* the interest we’ll pay over the next 19 years.

While *Building on Faith* does not conclude until March 31, you who are able might consider prepaying the balance of your pledge to immediately reduce the principal of the loan and the interest due each month.

Those of you who have become a part of our congregation since the launch of the campaign two years ago, might you also give a special gift to reduce the debt? Designate your gift “Building Fund.”

Above all, receive the thanks of a grateful church for each dollar given, many of which have been given sacrificially. And we thank and praise God who has brought us this far on our journey. While the building is now built, may God bless us to continue building his church.

The Advent Challenge



Sometimes our penchant for Christmas gift giving leaves me wondering, “Whose birthday is it, anyway?” I’m not going to pile on with a “presents bad, Jesus good” routine... Perhaps we can have it both ways.

Consider this Advent challenge: In the name of Jesus, **give half of what you’d spend on Christmas gifts to those suffering extreme poverty.** PVUMC’s Council on Ministries has designated the people of **Haiti** as recipients of our special Advent offering. In fully meeting the challenge, some might give half of their gift-giving budget; others might match dollar-for-dollar what they’re spending on family and friends. Then again, even the smallest of gifts may help save a life.

The first \$1,000 dollars received will go to our own North East District to purchase **building supplies** for the spring district mission trip to Haiti. Monies received beyond that will go to **Haiti Emergency**, Advance # 418325. (*The Advance* is an accountable, designated-giving arm of The United Methodist Church that ensures 100 percent of each gift reaches its intended mission or ministry.) PVUMC made a strong response following January’s earthquake; the need for relief continues to be great, especially with the threatening cholera epidemic on the heels of Hurricane Tomas rainfall.
