Confessions of a Tither

The first of July is upon us. Hard to believe we're halfway through 2011! At this midpoint I invite you to review your giving to the church.

There is concern about our church finances among our leaders. So far this year some \$27,000 worth of monthly mortgage payments have come from our steadily diminishing building fund. Yet I know that if even half of us gave a tenth, or *tithe*, of our income, we would fully meet our budget. I'm encouraging our leaders to

- 1) Review their own giving. Are they giving a tenth of *their* income to the church or moving in that direction?
- 2) Be relentless in our shared mission of making fully devoted followers of Christ.

Being good managers of all that God entrusts to us is part of our discipleship. Let me ask you: How are you doing in your giving?



Confessions of a Tither, Continued...

Below is a chart of 2010 giving to the general fund. My eyes immediately go to my family’s giving and I’m concerned that there are not more people above Jill & me. We give a tenth of our income to the general fund of PVUMC. My goal is to also give a tenth of the value of the housing the church provides us; that’s a stretch for us. Were I retired, my goal would be to give not less than 10% of what I was living on.

One of the things I’ve learned is that tithing sometimes keeps me from meeting some very worthwhile financial goals. For instance, I would love to be able to save enough to send my three children to college. I’ve run the numbers and there’s just no way we can do this at my present income while meeting higher priorities, including tithing. The cash we use says, “In God We Trust” and that’s my policy. Put God first (in all things, not just money) and trust God to provide. If my kids need to go to college, God will make a way for them to go. Maybe what we can set aside will be enough. Maybe we’ll receive a windfall. Given the ages of our kids it may be another 16 years before God’s trustworthiness in this matter can be fully proven. You can ask me then how it all worked out. Or you can trust God right now and have your own story to share.
