# Money Matters

### A Word About Tithing

The tithe is the spiritual discipline by which Christian disciples practice generosity. The Old Testament law required that the first 10 percent of the harvest be given back to God in gratitude for God's generosity. In fact, the prophet said that if we don't give the tithe, we are robbing God. (Malachi 3:8)

But for those who have experienced the generosity of God at the cross, the law is only the beginning. The tithe is the bare minimum below which we do not allow our generosity to fall. Some say that the tithe is a good place for generosity to begin, but a bad place for generosity to end. We are called to go beyond the law and to give in extravagant generosity in response to the extravagant generosity of God. The amazing thing is that when we practice generosity, we experience more of the generosity of God.

Here's an email written to Pastor Jim Harnish by a man from the Hyde Park UMC congregation during their stewardship emphasis a couple years ago:

Each year, at this time, I take a long, hard look at my budget. I begin by first subtracting the 10 percent tithe. Then I subtract 10 percent for savings. That leaves me 80 percent, right? By the time I subtract those expenses I have no control over: taxes, insurance, etc... the 10-10-80 formula becomes 10-10-40-40. It baffles me that Uncle Sam and my insurance companies get 4 times more than God. But I've learned not to worry about that ... since I have zero control over it. Then I cut my personal expenses down to match what is left. Each year this gets harder and harder to do. But strangely, I find this "cleansing" very freeing. Each year I learn that I can live without "stuff" that I thought I had to have. And I find that I don't even miss those things. It is amazing. In fact, it is a miracle! Each year God shows me that indeed he is faithful to me when I honor his tithe. I used to dread this time of year, but now I look forward to it knowing that God will once again teach me something new. Well, I guess I better get busy on my budget for this year. I can't wait!

## Coming Thursday Evenings: *DISCIPLE III Remember Who You Are*

Resident in the title is the driving idea in this study – the connection between memory and identity as the people of God. The word *You* in the title is meant to be heard both in its singular form (the individual) and in its plural form (the community). We are a community of memory. Participants in this thirty-two-week study will read the major and minor Old Testament prophets, with the exception of Daniel, and will read the thirteen letters traditionally attributed to Paul. To establish the historical context in which the prophets spoke for God, daily reading assignments also draw on the books of Deuteronomy through Chronicles. Study of the prophets will follow their historical sequence rather than their biblical sequence. The dating of Paul's letters influences the sequence of their study.
