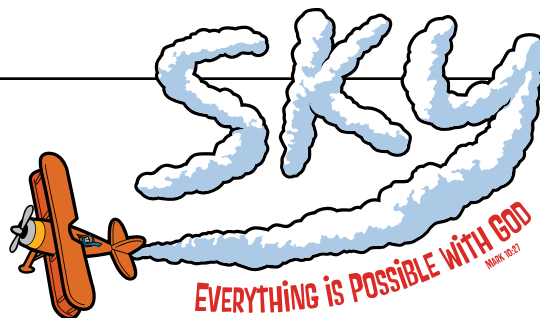

After all the hard work was completed the group attended Sunday worship with the children. Below is a sample of how the members of PVUMC who participated in this special weekend were impacted.

"My heart was touched so much when the 3 five- to seven-year old children (who came into the home this week) came back from being introduced to the congregation and the one little girl looked back at us with her quilt and stuffed animal (monkey) with a big smile on her face. Thank you to the quilters in our church who make quilts for these children."

"I have replayed those little girls at church receiving their love quilts. That act of kindness brought me to my knees. I am very thankful our UMW does the quilting for new residents of FUMCH."

"It was an awesome weekend with other Christians from PVUMC working for the Lord. Our church should be proud to be affiliated with this wonderful mission serving children."

"What I enjoyed most was our time together at the kitchen table. The relaxed schedule of the weekend gave us an opportunity to share memories of our past. Our normal busy lives don't usually allow for this type of sharing."

"It brought back memories of going to church camp. Sleeping with lots of other people, sharing meals together, working together to help the children. Question: Who are the minor prophets?

Answer: In the Old Testament, the word "prophet" was understood in two ways. First, a prophet was considered to be someone who boldly spoke the word of God to others. Prophets were not politicians! They were simply honest servants of God. Secondly, a prophet might also predict a future event based upon interpreting God's words in scripture. The Old Testament is divided into the major and minor prophets. The major prophets are the longer books of Isaiah, Jeremiah and Ezekiel. The minor prophets are the twelve shorter books that include the following: Daniel, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi.

You'll have an opportunity to sign-up for your project shortly, but here's a preview of the choices to consider:

- Beach Clean-Up:** Jacksonville Beach Pier
- Jacksonville Zoo:** Project to be determined, but they are looking for 20 volunteers
- St Francis House:** Feeding the homeless, small construction projects
- Emergency Services Coalition:** Providing baskets for homeless families in transitional living situations
- BEAM:** Stocking Food Pantry Shelves, possible painting project
- Sandwich Handout:** Preparation of bagged lunches and delivery to the homeless in downtown Jacksonville
- Families vs. Hunger:** Meal preparation for hungry families beyond our community
- VBS Craft Preparation:** Family friendly project where adults and children will make and decorate crafts that will be used at VBS at our church and Lincolnville VBS.
- Church Maintenance Projects:** Cleaning and small maintenance tasks within our church
- Hart-Felt Ministries:** Light yard work/landscaping at elderly homes
- Association of Retarded Citizens (ARC):** Light landscaping

After a brief time of worship at 9:30am, we'll get to work with our service teams! At noon, we'll meet back at the church to talk about our projects and enjoy a cookout celebration at the church.
