“Teaching Moment”

I answer your questions in this column so feel free to call the office, ask in person, or email me with your Bible questions.

Question: The remnant is mentioned 85 times in the Old Testament and 6 times in the New Testament. Who is the remnant?

Answer: The Anchor Bible Commentary states that a remnant may be defined as “what is left of a country after it undergoes a catastrophe.” Since the Bible was written over a period of hundreds of years, the meaning of “remnant” developed over time and was based on historical and Biblical context. In Isaiah 10:20-22, the “remnant” refers to a small group of Israelites who survive the invasion of the Assyrian army in 720 BC. A few verses later, in Isaiah 11:11-16, the “remnant” is promised that they will be brought back to the promised land by Yahweh. The Assyrian army sometimes deported these Israelites to various areas and so these verses from Isaiah 11 are a promise that they will one day return to their native land. Later, in Ezra, Nehemiah, Haggai, and Zechariah, the “remnant” refers to the Jewish survivors who have returned from Babylonian captivity. Babylonian leaders might kill, deport or enslave these native Jews but those who are fortunate enough to return to their native land one day are called the “remnant”. In the New Testament, the “remnant” is referred to in Revelation 12:17 as those who “keep the commandments of God” and “have the testimony of Jesus Christ.”

Wycliffe Bible Translators/JAARS is working around the world to bring the Gospel to groups of people who are going to hear it for the very first time. If you are interested in learning more about this work, a trip to **JAARS Day** in Waxhaw, North Carolina is being planned **August 10-12**. Our goal will to learn more about how we can support their work and to have some fun and fellowship. In addition to learning about the translation work, jungle airplane, helicopter and jeep rides will be available for the adventure seekers. 
Kingdom Kids

A Note From Pastor Jeff:

Wow... What a month May has been. We ushered it in with Ministry Fair Sunday (awesome) and closed it out with Serve Sunday (also awesome) and Pentecost which hasn't yet occurred as I write this but I can tell you I'm pumped about it. You never know how God might choose to show up.

Four years ago my family found a caterpillar on the berm behind our yard. We kept it on our patio, watching it create a chrysalis and emerge as a beautiful bright orange gulf fritillary butterfly. This year we went caterpillar hunting and captured five beauties of different sizes. One has already begun his (her?) chrysalis. We all enjoy watching this and we'll be waiting in great anticipation for butterflies to emerge. If it doesn't happen before our three-day trip to Orlando, I imagine these cocooned critters may be going for a ride in the minivan.

It still strikes me as miraculous that a worm-like insect can become a beautifully winged butterfly. It's no less amazing that people can undergo just as radical a transformation. We're still who we are (fritillary caterpillars don't become monarch butterflies) yet when we trust and follow Jesus we are transformed, fulfilling the potential with which we were created.

It's my prayer that you and all of us together as the church will become what God created us to be. Ministry Fair, Serve Sunday, small group Bible studies, VBS, and more... I love what I already see. And the best is yet to come!
