

A Note From Pastor Jeff:

A single mom dies in a car accident. A woman 22 months into recovery from a lifethreatening stroke suffers another stroke and dies. Two deaths too close to each other in the month of February have me repeating this sentence oft spoken at funerals: "In the midst of life we are in death; to whom may we turn for help but to you, most merciful God?"

We often deceive ourselves by thinking that our lives are under our control. They are not. While we each choose how we act and how we react, life happens. Sometimes we simply suffer the consequences of our choices, at other times it's simply life. (And along the way I've learned not to confuse life with God.)

All of this makes me glad for the resurrection of Christ. I see a cross where Jesus of Nazareth, fully human and fully divine, dies that we might be forgiven our sins. I see a tomb open and empty, reminding me that his resurrection frees me from sin and the forever death that results.

It's not yet Easter but already I'm reminded of that old preacher's shout, "Friday's here, but Sunday's comin'!"
