Why are we going? To support bible translation so that families like the one below can be transformed by hearing God's Word in a language they can understand. There is a great response when people hear the Word for the first time.





What are we going to do there? Service projects such as landscaping or renovating an apartment, some team members may work individually in various JAARS departments such as in Housekeeping, Construction and Maintenance, Food Services, or department offices. Be assured we will find a project that matches your skills. We will also participate in JAARS Day with opportunities for jungle jeep, helicopters and airplane rides.

What is JAARS is Wycliffe's support group providing everything from Housing, Information Technology, Transportation, and whatever else it takes to support Bible translators in the field. 50% of the work at the JAARS facility is done by part time volunteers. Anyone over the age of 14 [14-17 with parental/guardian supervision] can participate.

Estimated cost for lodging & transportation \$395 per person single occupancy; less if you share a room.


