Box Tops for Education



In today's economy most school systems struggle to make ends meet. Since 1996, the **Box Tops for Education** program has helped schools across America earn cash for the things they need. You can help **St Paul's School of Excellence** (a charter school in the Lincolnville area of St. Augustine) by clipping Box Tops for Education. Hundreds of products participate in the program, and you probably already have several in your pantry, freezer and fridge. Every box top you clip is worth 10 cents. That may not sound like a lot, but it adds up quickly. Each school can receive up to \$20,000 per school year from clipped box tops! Saint Paul School of Excellence



St. Paul School of Excellence is a free charter school in the Lincolnville area of St. Augustine. Ponte Vedra UMC has partnered with this school in many areas with the goal of improving the educational outcomes of the children. While we provide every student in this school with a weekend backpack of food as part of our Blessings in a Backpack Ministry, we've recognized that we can do so much more to impact the lives of these children by providing some of the assistance and tools they need to succeed. Education and opportunity go hand in hand in helping children out of poverty.

Recently, the children's groups at Ponte Vedra UMC collected enough books to supply every student with a book at Christmas. **Laura Lovett** has worked with the library at a school in Ponte Vedra Beach to obtain books for the library at St. Paul's to help insure that they meet the common core standards. Additionally, **Phyllis Monie** has insured that St. Paul's received software that will assist these students in the development of math skills. And since St. Paul's does not have an art program, **Jenn Smith** assists the school by providing an art workshop to all of the grades whenever possible.

Attention!



The Flamingos have escaped from Busch Gardens! One of the PVUMC students left the cage open during our annual visit, and now they are migrating toward us! At the current progression, they will be landing in the Ponte Vedra Beach area on **Saturday, March 1 between 10:00am and 3:00pm**. On that day they can land on ANY lawn they want, and they make a MESS!

In order to repent for their blunder, the youth of PVUMC have been taking classes in flamingo removal, and will be willing to help you out (for a small fee!) If, on March 1, your lawn happens to be “flocked” by the flamingos, you can call the flamingo removal hotline (and the youth will come out and remove them immediately (for a fee of \$30). Plus, for an additional \$3, you can choose where the flamingos go next!

Or, you can bypass the potential mess all together and buy flamingo insurance for your house. For just \$25, you can rest safely knowing you will not be bothered by these pink birds. (You will be given the opportunity to purchase your insurance on Sundays after worship from February 9, 16 & 23). Or you may buy insurance by emailing kelly1.minter@pv-umc.org. All proceeds go toward the summer 2014 mission trips for middle school and high school.



(For those who are confused: Every year we do a pink flamingo fundraiser. For 3 weeks we set up a table and people can buy insurance for \$25 (which means you WILL NOT be bothered on the day of the event) or they can write down the name of a friend (for a small fee) that they want to flock to be sent to. Then on March 1 the youth get together, most of them dressed up like flamingos, and they stand on the lawns of church members and friends. The homeowner is given a paper with a phone number on it (the flamingo removal hotline). Once they call them, the “removal team” shows up and collects the flamingos (and the removal fee of \$30). You may suggest the next place we go, too! This is a great fundraiser, and tons of fun!)

Spring Study: Adam Hamilton's "The Way"



I was a history major in college. Someone once asked, “If you could meet any historical figure, who would it be?” That was a simple question for me to answer. It would be Jesus. Though I admire President Abraham Lincoln and inventor Thomas Edison, it was Jesus who used his simple message and life to change the world. **This spring we have an opportunity to walk in the footsteps of Jesus by reading Adam Hamilton's “The Way”.** In his book, Hamilton, the pastor of the largest United Methodist Church in the United States, takes a look at some key moments in Jesus' life and ministry. When you read it you'll experience what it means to truly walk in the shadow of Christ and become more like Jesus. 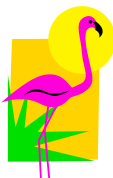

A Note From Pastor Jeff:

I've recently spent time with an old friend, "My Utmost for His Highest" by Oswald Chambers, available as a 30-day devotional through the app *YouVersion*. I wonder if Chambers' words might apply to any others of us who are not naturally (or more to the point, *supernaturally*) bold. Chambers writes,

And beware of exhibiting religious deceit by saying, "Oh, I have no misgivings about Jesus, only misgivings about myself." If we are honest, we will admit that we never have misgivings or doubts about ourselves, because we know exactly what we are capable or incapable of doing. But we do have misgivings about Jesus. ...

My misgivings arise from the fact that I search within to find how He will do what He says. My doubts spring from the depths of my own inferiority. If I detect these misgivings in myself, I should bring them into the light and confess them openly – "Lord, I have had misgivings about You. I have not believed in Your abilities, but only my own. And I have not believed in Your almighty power apart from my finite understanding of it."

Oswald Chambers has got my number! Perhaps you too will find the prayer he offers helpful: **O Lord, with what abundant relief I turn to You! I need You in unfathomable ways, and with what amazed relief and joy I find all I need in You.**
