Update on 2.5 Acre Property

The PVUMC Trustees contracted with Goodson Nevin & Assoc. Consulting Engineers (GNA) to apply for a stormwater Environmental Resource Permit (ERP) for the adjacent 2.5 acre property purchased last September. (GNA had done the civil engineering on the original 5 acre property and recommended we apply before an anticipated rule change took place.) The St Johns Water Management District has issued a permit authorizing construction of a Stormwater Management System with stormwater treatment by Wet Detention for Ponte Vedra United Methodist Church South Parcel Expansion. (Please note that this is not a *building* permit.) This permit will expire five years from the date of issuance which was May 30, 2014.

PVUMC will soon publish a notice in a local newspaper advising the public that we have been issued a permit for this project, notifying members of the public of their right to challenge the issuance of the permit. Once proper notice is given by newspaper publication there is a 21-day time limit to file a petition challenging the issuance of the permit.

Plans are not yet in place to improve the property. Your Trustees have simply acted to preserve the church's ability to develop the property as intended at the time of its purchase, that is, primarily for parking.

JAARS Mission Trip

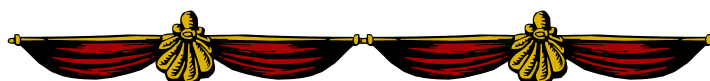


Bible translation is about giving people the best resource for knowing God. The Bible provides a complete picture of God's love, holiness and the redemption of humanity. It is the best tool we have for becoming more like Christ and a translated Bible can redefine our relationship with God. Having a Bible in your own language can be transformational for an individual or an entire community. JAARS provides practical, day-to-day support to assist in making Bible translation possible.

PVUMC's Mission Team, led by **Dan** and **Frances Thomas**, spent a week in June at the Wycliffe/JAARS facility in Waxhaw, NC, working non-stop on projects on campus and in the hangar where planes are prepared for trips to Africa and the Pacific. The team learned about the Matses', a cannibalistic tribe who kidnapped women from other tribes for wives. Two Wycliffe missionaries made contact and translated the Bible into their language. The Matses' are now a transformed people with many who have dedicated their lives to Jesus and are now a literate community able to attend school and advance their living conditions.
