Beginning February 15: The God We Can Know

Our spring church-wide study this year follows the recently published book *The God We Can Know* by Rob Fuquay. This 7-week worship and study series will help us all find and form an answer to the most essential question in the Christian faith, the question Jesus asked of his disciples, “**Who do you say I am?**” Jesus’ “I am” statements grab our imagination by revealing more about his purpose, shape our own Christian identity and connect us to the God of Moses, the Great *I Am*. Images of bread, light, shepherd, vine, and more give us ways to experience Jesus anew and to discover a God who is close and wants to be known. The message series begins Sunday, February 15. **Books and small group sign up sheets** are available in the foyer. (An excellent weekly video recorded mostly in Israel accompanies the small group studies.)

Double Down on Debt

PVUMC received a large matching gift in December to be used to reduce the church’s mortgage debt. This gift of \$100,000 fully matched would yield \$200,000 to be paid against our debt of \$2.1 million. Meeting this goal will satisfy the \$64,000 parsonage mortgage and, by applying the monthly parsonage payment to the church facility debt, reduce the time needed to pay off the sanctuary building from more than 14 years to less than 11. This is a tremendous opportunity to free the church of the future for increased mission and ministry. Designate your gift “**Debt Reduction.**” (This is a listed option in our online giving service. Serving Homeless Families through Family Promise

Family Promise of Jacksonville (<http://www.familypromisejax.org>) is a non-profit, interfaith hospitality network providing temporary assistance, hospitality and case management for families with children experiencing homelessness.

Family Promise's economical, individualized plans help families take the necessary steps toward lasting independence. Each family receives the resources necessary to maintain a healthy life including **overnight accommodations at a local congregation**, three meals a day, access to shower and laundry facilities and transportation to school or work. Additionally Family Promise aims to get every family back on their feet as soon as possible through intensive case management, social support and linkage with applicable social and educational services. This innovative model of care operates at 1/3 the cost of a traditional shelter.

Our church's opportunity to serve would come through hosting 2 - 3 families for 7 consecutive nights, likely three times per year. Families would enjoy a meal prepared by us and sleep in our upstairs classrooms. A host individual or couple would spend the night in the building also. (Folding beds are provided by Family Promise.) Transportation to/from the church is provided by Family Promise, as is breakfast and lunch.

Intrigued? Family Promise Director **Mark Landschoot** is providing us an **information session** on **Thursday, February 19** from **4 to 5pm**. Please come and learn about this incredible opportunity we have to serve.
