Double Down on Debt

In December PVUMC received a \$100,000 matching gift to be used to reduce the church's mortgage debt. As of February 15 we'd received \$26,084 which when doubled nearly satisfies our \$64,000 parsonage mortgage. (Our next report will be Sunday, March 1.) Fully matching this gift pays off the parsonage and reduces the time needed to pay off the sanctuary building from more than 14 years to less than 11. This is a tremendous opportunity to free the church of the future for increased mission and ministry. Your gift designated "**Debt Reduction**" will be doubled! (Debt Reduction is a listed option in our online giving service. See pv-umc.org/give for details on online giving.) Our opportunity to *Double Down on Debt* concludes **March 31**.

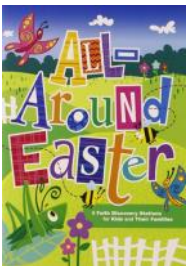
United Methodist Women News

A Note From Pastor Jeff.

I read the quote in the Times-Union the day after Ash Wednesday. **“It’s really quick and easy; you just come and go home.”** The 12-year-old was talking about a roadside opportunity to receive ashes. On the one hand, I’m *very* much in favor of taking church to the streets and I encourage everyone who does this. On the other hand, “quick and easy” is a cultural value that cuts against following Jesus. While not everything about following Jesus is long and difficult, Jesus did say, “If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me.” (Luke 9:23) That sounds neither quick nor easy.

I get the culture; I live in it every day. Even in church I hear about how it’s just too much for people to spend an hour in worship *and* another hour in a small group Bible study, or teaching the faith to children, or helping the good news of Jesus become real to youth. Jesus gets an hour a week. Quick and easy.

I hope that during this season of Lent you are in some way making a sacrifice for the sake of your relationship with Jesus. May you grow closer to the One who gave his life for you and wants to give his life to you.
